• **CONSENT AGENDA**

Regarding the Past Due Report, customer #0030761000 water was shut off. Regarding the Ambulance Report, the new radios are in. Trustee Piper made a motion to accept the Consent Agenda and Trustee Peyton seconded the motion.

Trustee Peyton explained to the board regarding the appropriation ordinance that most items stayed the same. He did add extra money for a few line items. He created a document that would have all budget items in one document. Trustee Peyton made a motion to adopt Ordinance #635, Annual Appropriation

Ordinance for the Fiscal Year Beginning May 1, 2026 and Ending April 30, 2027.
Trustee Piper seconded the motion.

Worker Matt Fields told the board that the community room bathroom floor had been redone but no sealing had been put on it. Fields asked if the village wanted to hire the sealing done or if the workers should do it. After discussion, it was decided that the workers would do the sealing.

- **DISCUSSION ITEMS**

Public Comments:

Patricia Schumm had received an ordinance violation letter and asked if she could have more time. Connie Robertson also asked if she could have more time. The board decided that they could have a month but Trustee Peyton explained that this was not a blanket extension for everyone.

Employee Reports:

Worker Fields told the board that all the summer workers had started. It was mentioned that the summer workers should clean the park playground equipment.

Worker Jasen Tubbs stated that he had put in an online bid for a 12 inch bucket for the backhoe. The bid was \$288.

Tubbs also told the board that Robby Anderson would begin the demolition of the old Shell Food Mart building. The 10 day waiting period is over.

Worker Kris Shreve reported that it was the two year anniversary for the water tower repair and it had been inspected. They had found 25 issues but none were serious and it was still under warranty.

Shreve also said that the gate had been added to the pump house.

Shreve told the board that one of the sewer effluent parameters (dissolved oxygen) had to be tested on site now. He had a quote from HACH for \$2,117.25 for a meter. There were no objections from the board to Shreve making the purchase.

Trustee Reports:

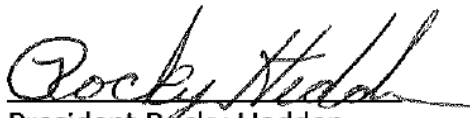
Trustee Peyton said that there had been a basketball league started that would utilize the basketball court in the park this summer. He also mentioned that he would like to see a disc golf course added in the future.

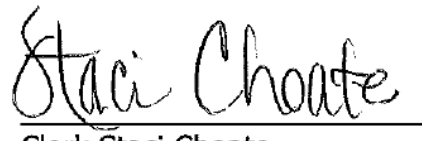
President Hedden reported that he had been getting complaints of 4 wheelers and side by sides riding around town. Someone had recently been drinking and flipped one over but no one was hurt.
